MERIT

- Set annual target goals for 2006, 2007 and 2008 on the Nursing Home STAR website for the following quality measures: physical restraints, high risk pressure ulcers, and chronic care pain
- Improve quality in one area: physical restraints, high risk pressure ulcers or chronic care pain*
- Submit CNA turnover forms for baseline, 2006 and 2007
- Submit resident and staff satisfaction for baseline and 2006
- Attended 50% of QIO-sponsored activities 2005-2007

ACHIEVEMENT

- Set annual target goals for 2006, 2007 and 2008 on the Nursing Home STAR website for the following quality measures physical restraints, high risk pressure ulcers, and chronic care pain
- Improve quality in two areas: physical restraints, high risk pressure ulcers or chronic care pain*
- Submit CNA turnover forms for baseline, 2006 and 2007
- Submit resident and staff satisfaction for baseline and 2006
- Attended 70% of QIO-sponsored activities 2005-2007

EXCELLENCE

- Set annual target goals for 2006, 2007 and 2008 on the Nursing Home STAR website for the following quality measures: physical restraints, high risk pressure ulcers, and chronic care pain
- Improve quality in all three areas: physical restraints, high risk pressure ulcers and chronic care pain*
- Submit CNA turnover forms for baseline, 2006 and 2007
- Submit resident and staff satisfaction for baseline and 2006
- Attended 80% of QIO-sponsored activities 2005-2007

Honorable Mention

- Facilities have met all of the criteria under “Merit” except improving quality in any 1 area of: physical restraints, high-risk pressure ulcers or chronic care pain.
